➤ **Overview of the Year 2024-2025**

This year we were able to touch more than 20000 persons belonging to the marginalised sections of the society such as the SC, ST, OBC & the BPL, through our various on-going projects, workshops, awareness Programmes, cultural Programmes, mobile dispensaries, street play, festivals and contact points across the villages.

This year also Dr. Ambedkar Mission laid special emphasis on reaching out to the beneficiaries at the village level by establishing direct contact and visiting their homes and work places in order to sensitize them with the various development activities carried out by the NGO and how they can benefit from it. We were overwhelmed with the response of the masses and assured them with all possible effort on our end to uplift their lives.

The interactions that the beneficiary families had with our team helped both ways the families could know what the Government of India is doing to develop them and we as an NGO understood the areas where we can put special emphasis in our future work.

Overview of Dr. Ambedkar Mission, Assam work during 2024-2025:

- The Ten Bedded Hospital was further strengthened by inducting new equipment and medicines. Free medicines were distributed. In total 48337 patients were able to avail treatment from the hospital.
- Mobile Dispensaries were periodically carried out in remote areas, especially during the flood situation. Altogether 17495 poor souls benefited from this scheme.
- 100 ST Students were given training in the trades of Computer Software, Computer Hardware, Garment Making, Fashion Design etc.
- 100 Students were newly enrolled in the School run by Dr. Ambedkar Mission. And along-with the existing enrolled students a total of 1000 students were imparted free education and free mid-day meals.

- The 133th Birth Anniversary of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar was observed at our mission premises on 14th April, 2024.
- Various Awareness Programs, Workshops & Street lays were also organized.
- Construction of boundary wall of the NGO Campus was taken with the help of Dept. of T&D, Govt. of Assam Under Untied Fund.

Ten Bedded Hospital for ST

The organization has been running a Ten Bedded Hospital at Dhopatari, with financial help from Ministry of Tribal Affairs since the year 2000. The hospital is located in the Campus of Dr. Ambedkar Mission, Assam in an Assam



Type Construction and has been continuously serving the poor and in-need ST people in and around Changsari, since its inception. The presence of the Hospital in the midst of such poor communities has brought much succour to the

lives of the people and they are able to look after their health properly without any cost. In addition to treatment the Hospital provides free of cost medicine and other medical necessities. It has both In-Patient Department (IPD) and Out-Patient Department (OPD) facilities.



We cater our services free of cost with the help of our specialized team consisting of Doctors, Nurses, Lab Technicians and other necessary Staffs. Ambulance service is also being provided to the needed patients during emergency time.

Snippets of the 10 Bedded Hospital Scheme 2024-2025

The 10 Bedded Hospital has a record of serving 43712 (OPD) Nos. and 2855 (IPD) Nos. of ST patients.

In total 48337 patients were able to avail treatment from the hospital, out of which 23159 patients were Male and 23408 were Female. Below 18 years were 1770 nos. of patients.

➤ Mobile Dispensary For ST (2024-2025)

Dr. Ambedkar Mission, Assam has started Mobile Dispensary Scheme for Scheduled Tribe (ST) in the year 2001 with financial help from Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MOTA), Govt. of India, to reach out the Scheduled Tribe (ST) people living in remote villages and provide them with free medical services. A fully equipped medical team comprising of Doctor and Nursing Staff, visiting the villages by a Toyota Innova with medicines and medical equipment. The team provides the beneficiaries with free medical treatment, free medicine and free medical advices to the patients. Since 2001 the poor ST people of the area, who I could not visit the city for medical treatment are getting free treatment at their doorsteps thanks to the Mobile Dispensary Scheme of Dr. Ambedkar Mission. The scheme has been running successfully since its inception. Below 18 years - 1123 persons were treated.

The Mobile Dispensary has served a total 17495 Nos. of Patients.

Education

Non-Residential Primary School for SC (Class I-V)

Education is the first step to eradicate many social evils and disparity. With this aim Dr. Ambedkar Mission has started **Green Hill Nursery School** in the year 1999-2000. It is a Non-Residential Primary School providing free Primary Education from Class I to Class V to the underprivileged SC Students of Changsari Area. Apart from regular classes the students are provided with



uniform, books, other study material and mid-day meal all on charitable basis. The school has received the recognition of the Government of Assam and is one of the best primary school in the Changsari Area. The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India has been kind enough to give financial help to the school to provide Free Education to

100 SC Students of poor families around Changsari area. We are also grateful to Honourable Ex- Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh for giving us a grant out of his MP LAD Fund for the school building. With such support from Govt. of India and other kind hearted person, Dr. Ambedkar Mission's



Green Hill Nursery School has become the first step of institutional education to many bright students of the Changsari area. We look forward to make this school one of the model school of the region, imparting superior

quality education and ray of hope to the children of the poor families around Changsari.

Snippets of Non Residential Primary School In for SC (Class I-V) (2024-2025)

Total 100 SC Students from the nearby areas were admitted into the school. Boys 41 nos. and Girls 59 nos. All the students were provided with uniform, books, other study material and mid-day meal at no cost.

Non-Residential Primary School for SC (Class VI-VIII)



In order to provide continuous education to the underprivileged students of Changsari, Dr. Ambedkar Mission has started an Upper Primary School at Dhopatari Village in the year 1999-2000. Here we are providing free education from Class VI to

Class VIII to 100 SC Students of poor families with the financial grant of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India. The students are also provided with uniform, books, other study material and mid-day meal all on charitable basis. In this way the students after getting the primary education can continue with their studies till 8th standard. This makes them eligible to take up any skill-based training in a vocational trade of their choice, so that they are equipped to earn a living and provide for their family. Thus, we at Dr. Ambedkar Mission ensure that any student, to whom we are able to provide our charitable work, becomes a better human and live a better life.

Secondary School For Scheduled Caste Students

In order to provide continuous education to the underprivileged students of Changsari, Dr. Ambedkar Mission are also providing free education to the student of Class IX and Class X. Dr. Ambedkar Mission is situated in such an area where 90% of people belongs to the SC community. Most of the people earn their live hood by fishing and selling fish. Most of them do not even have any land for cultivation of crops. The organization observed that most of the children attend the School empty stomach due to acute poverty.

The organization has been working relentlessly in the field of education of the SC community and therefore along with our School. Other facilities such as games & sports, library, performing cultural activities are also being adequately provided to ensure their holistic development.

Snippets of Non-Residential Primary School for SC (Class VI-VIII) (2024-2025)

In total 100 SC Students from the nearby areas were admitted into the school. Boys 56 nos. Girls 44 nos.

All the students are provided with free uniform, books and other study materials along with mid-day meal at no cost.

Skill-based and Vocational Training

Livelihood Project for Tribal

The Livelihood Project for ST beneficiaries at Boko, Kamrup District, Assam was initiated in 2023. Targeted at 100 Scheduled Tribe beneficiaries, the project aims to improve the economic well-being of individuals or communities



by enhancing their access to income-generating activities, often through skill development, asset building, market linkages and resource management. We aimed at improving the economic conditions through development of Agriculture, Packaging, Marketing etc. at entire Kamrup District. The project seeks to enhance agricultural productivity, promote sustainable practices, and empower farmers through skill development and market access. The project focuses on empowering tribal communities by leveraging their local resources and skills while providing technical and institutional support to ensure market-driven production and economic self-sufficiency.





Snippets of Skill-based and Vocational Training (2024-2025)

In the Computer Hardware Trade 20 ST Students were given theoretical and practical training.

Similarly, in the trades of Computer Software, Computer Hardware, Garment Making, Fashion Design etc. also 20 Students were selected from the ST Community out of many applications and given training both in theory and practical.

The beneficiaries also received monthly stipend as per the norms. Entrepreneurship skill were also imparted to these students.

Training & Tool kit distribution to 68 local Artisans. They were also given Design and Technical development training as well as Skill- up -gradation trainings. Integrated design and technical development workshops were carried out. And also, Entrepreneurship Development Workshop.

Garment Industry

At Dr. Ambedkar Mission, Assam, the ultimate aim of all our skill development training and vocational trade centres is to help the youths find a means of livelihood – either through direct employment or through self -development. Thus, we want our students to be industry ready. Here the students can work



under real environment and learn how to start and operate a business, hence being self-employed. The number of beneficiaries is 30. The products prepared by them are highly appreciated in the markets.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

TEN BEDDED HOSPITAL FOR ST

10 Bedded Hospital is often necessary due to several reasons:

Limited Health Care Access: Tribal areas are typically remote and isolated, making it challenging for tribal communities to access health care facilities.

Having a 10 bedded hospital in these areas ensured that essential medical services are available closer to the communities, reducing the need for long and arduous journeys to urban centres for health care.

Increased Vulnerability to health issues: Tribal populations often face specific health challenges including higher rates of communicable diseases, malnutrition and material and child health issues. These populations may also

have unique cultural practises and health beliefs and require specialized health care interventions. Having a dedicated hospital allows for targeted health care delivery and specialized treatment for tribal specific health concerns.

Emergencies and Accidents: Accidents and emergencies can occur anywhere and tribal areas are no exception. Establishing a 10 bedded hospital ensures that immediate medical attention can be provided to individuals who experience injuries or other medical emergencies. This timely responds can significantly impact survival rates and prevent long term complications.

Maternal and Child Health Care: Access to proper maternal and child health care services is crucial in tribal areas where the rates of material and infant mortality tend to be higher compared to urban areas. 10 bedded hospital can offer prenatal care, safe deliveries, neonatal care and postnatal services, providing better health care outcomes for tribal mothers and their children.

Local Health Care Employment: Establishing a hospital in tribal areas creates employment opportunities for health care professional within the community. This can help address the issue of limited health care workforce in these areas and foster local economic development.

Community Trust and Cultural Sensitivity: Tribal communities often have their own district cultural practices, languages and traditions. 10 bedded in tribal areas can be designed to be culturally sensitive, accommodating the specific needs and preferences of the local community. This can help build trust and increase health care utilization among the tribal populations.

10 Bedded Hospital in Tribal Areas is essential to address the unique the health care challenges faced by the communities, improve health care access, provide specialized care, respond to emergencies and ensured culturally sensitive health care services.

LOCATION OF THE PROJECT

Dr. Ambedkar Mission, 10 Bedded Hospital is located at Dhopatari, Changsari with the Financial help from Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MOTA) since the year 2000. The hospital is located in the campus of Dr. Ambedkar Mission, Assam in an Assam Type Construction and has been continuously serving the poor and in-need ST people and around Changsari since its inception.

Dr. Ambedkar Mission, Assam Has started Mobile Dispensary Scheme for Scheduled Tribe (ST) in the year 2001 with the Financial help from Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MOTA), Govt. of India to reach out the Scheduled Tribe (ST) people living in remote villages and provide them with free medical services with the help of our tea comprising of Doctor and Nursing Staff with medicines and medical equipments. Some of the Target Villages are: Pukhuripar, Dagaon, Simila, Gopalpur, Tengajhar, Balabari, Bhakajan, Roumari, etc.

MOBILE DISPENSARY FOR ST

Mobile dispensary can play a crucial role in providing health care services to tribal areas for several reasons:

Geographical Challenges: Tribal areas are often located in remote and inaccessible regions, where infrastructure and transportation facilities are limited. Mobile dispensary can overcome these challenges by reaching out to the tribal communities directly, ensuring they have access to essential health care services.

Limited Health Care Infrastructure: Tribal areas typically lack proper health care facilities such as hospitals, clinics and pharmacies. Mobile dispensary acts as a means to bridge this gap by bringing medical professionals and medical directly to the tribal communities.

Health Care Awareness and Education: Many tribal communities have limited knowledge about health care practises, preventive measures and available treatment, mobile dispensaries can serve a platform for health care professionals to educate and raise awareness about various health issues, hygiene practises and disease prevention.

Cultural Sensitivity: Tribal communities often have unique cultural practises, benefits and languages. Mobile dispensaries staffed with health care professionals who are familiar with the local culture and language can provide health care services in a manner that respect and understands the tribal community specific needs and preferences.

Outreach and Follow-up Care: Mobile dispensary can conduct regular visit to tribal areas, allowing on going health care services, follow-up care and monitoring of chronic conditions. This ensures that individuals in tribal communities receive continuous medical attention and necessary treatment.

Emergency Response: In the case of medical emergencies, mobile dispensary can provide immediate health care support before the patient can be transferred to a more specialized facility. Promote medical intervention can be vital in saving lives and reducing the negative health impacts in tribal areas.

NON-RESIDENTIAL PRIMARY SCHOOL FOR SC

Education is the first step to eradicate many social evils and disparity. In order to provide continuous education to the underprivileged students of Changsari, Dr. Ambedkar Mission has started Green Hill Nursery School (Class: I - V) and Upper Primary School at Dhopatari Village (Class: VI - VIII) in the year 1999-2000. Our aim is to provide free education to the underprivileged Scheduled Caste students of Changsari Area. We also provided uniform, books, other study material and mid-day meal all on charitable basis.

To provide continuous education of Class VI to VIII to the underprivileged students of Changsari, Dr. Ambedkar Mission has started an Upper Primary School at Dhopatari Village in the year 1999-2000 with the help of the Financial Grant of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India.

Education from Class I to V to the Underprivileged SC Students of Changsari Area. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India has been kind enough to give financial help to the School to provide Free Education to 100 SC Students of poor families around Changsari Area.

Dr. Ambedkar Mission has started Green Hill Nursery School in the year 1999- 2000. It is a Non- Residential Primary School providing free Primary.
